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2. All persons aged over 16 years and resident in the community council area can stand for election. There are 13 places available for election.

- **Uncontested Election Meeting**

Should 13 or less nominations be received by the closing date, the uncontested election meeting will take place on 26th October 2017 and will begin at 7.30pm in Heart of Scotstoun Community Centre, 64 Balmoral St, Glasgow G14 0BL

- **Contested Election – Secret Ballot**

If more than 13 nominations are received by the closing date then a secret ballot will take place on a date to be confirmed in Heart of Scotstoun Community Centre, 64 Balmoral St, Glasgow G14 0BL commencing at 5.30pm and finishing at 8.30pm.

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3. All persons aged over 16 years and resident in the community council area are entitled to vote in elections.
 4. All proposers and seconders must also be resident in the community council area and aged over 16 years.
 5. Candidates, proposers and seconders names should appear on either the Electoral Register or a Supplementary List.

- **Supplementary List**

An application form to be included on a Supplementary List may be obtained from Democratic Services, telephone 0141 287 0060.

Only the supplementary list application form must be returned with the necessary proof of residency e.g. Council Tax notice, recent utility bills etc., and ideally photographic/signature evidence e.g. driving license etc., no later than 12 noon on Friday 15th September 2017.

- **Term of Office**

6. Successful candidates will be elected to sit on the community council until the next scheduled election to be held in October 2021.
